By May 16th, all submissions will receive a response indicating whether your submission has been accepted and, if not, suggesting alternative options for your session.

What happens after you are accepted as an RSHI 2025 conference speaker?

- Ensure you are a member of the Institute, register for the conference, and arrange for hotel and travel. Don't wait; take advantage of early bird pricing for travel.
- Preparing a presentation can be stressful, and we want to support you throughout the creative process. After May 16th, each speaker will be assigned a conference mentor. In other words, this person is someone you can approach with conference questions, serve as a sounding board, and provide support if any obstacles arise.
- We request speakers prepare a visual presentation to accompany their content when presenting at the conference.
- We kick off the first of three RSHI speaker review sessions in July. This hour offers
 the speakers time to get to know one another, and speakers can begin sharing their
 content. The RSHI speaker review session dates are July 31st, August 28th, and
 October 2nd, so be on the lookout for these Zoom invites.

- Please organize your comments and presentation to ensure they are completed within the specific time frame for your event.

- To ensure a smooth event, you will be asked to participate in a tech and content runthrough. We will contact you to schedule this. We will also require a review of your content prior to the event.
